We never talked about our family history when I was growing up and now everyone is gone and I don't know anything!" You will learn what you need to know to get started, what is involved in doing research, where to gather information, how to keep your findings in logical order, and lots more. It's never too late to begin!

Dealing with Idiosyncrasies of Slovenian Genealogy Research!

Numerous obstacles, Slovene in nature, may stop you in your tracks! What to do?
