CAN – lahko, ne more

1. He can come any minute.
2. I can speak English.
3. You can go to the cinema.
4. Can you open the window, please?
5. We can go earlier if you like.

COULD – bi lahko, ne bi mogel

1. He could come any minute.
2. I could jump very high.
3. You could go to the cinema.
4. Could you help me, please?
5. We could go earlier if you like.

MUST – mora, ne sme

1. He must be in his room now.
2. You must stop at the traffic lights.
3. You mustn't smoke here.

HAVE TO – mora, ni treba

1. I have to come to school in time.
2. I don't have to answer this question.

NEED TO – mora, ni treba

1. I need to walk.
2. I don't need to go to Ljubljana.

MAY – sme, ne sme

1. There may be life on other planets.
2. You may leave.

MIGHT – mogoče bo

1. If you use this knife, you might cut yourself.

WILL – bo

1. Will you clean the blackboard, please?
2. Will you have a cup of tea?

WOULD – bi

1. Would you open the window, please?
2. Would you like some biscuits?

SHALL – naj

1. Shall we play table tennis?

SHOULD – moral bi, ne bi smel

1. You should write homework regularly.
2. You should go to the dentist's.
You shouldn't wait any longer.
3. You shouldn't dump rubbish here.

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
